Clayton's Lesson began when students at Oliver Springs High School began wearing t-shirts with the superman emblem in honor of Clayton. Donna saw the student's passion and used this to create Clayton's Lesson by having t-shirts professionally made with the superman emblem as well as the words, "Clayton's Lesson". Following Donna's presentation, Nathan Wray presented a slideshow entitled, "Celebration of Success" which included an overview of RCADC's activities from 2018. Some highlights of the report were: 1,279.8 pounds of medication were collected in Roane County, 107 presentations were given reaching 5,556 community members, and 33, 871 substance abuse prevention materials were disseminated in the community.
