208 presentations were given during FY22 reaching 12,781 community members

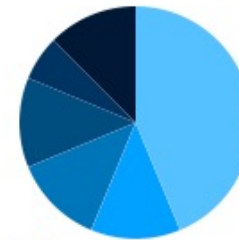
Community Impact

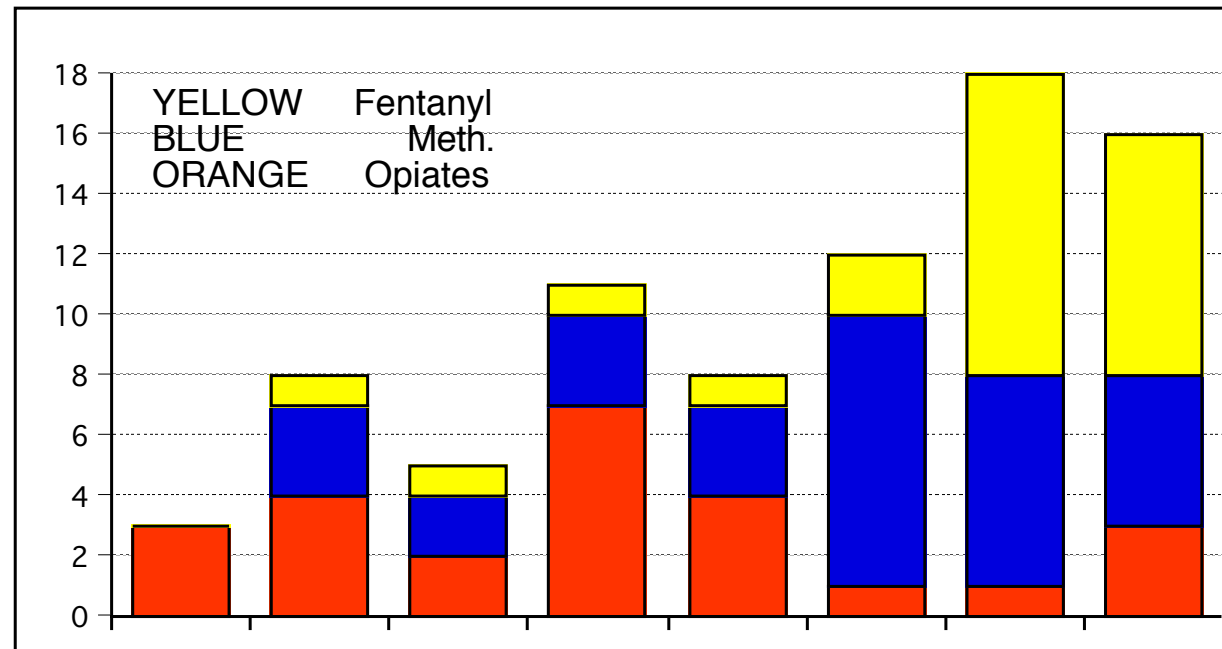
