- -The mission of the Avalon Center is to end power-based violence against men, women and children and to achieve social justice.
- -In 2021-2022, the Avalon Center served 180 adult victims of domestic violence, sheltered 36 victims of sexual assault, ten of which were from Roane County.
- -The Avalon Center operates under complete confidentiality for every client served.
